

## What is a DBE Certification?

A Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) certification requires your business to be owned, controlled, and operated by governmentrecognized disadvantaged groups. If you own a small business enterprise and fall within such a group, you could be **missing out on Government Contracting opportunities.** 

An 8(a) Certification at the Federal level is the most lucrative certification for disadvantaged entities. However, it is the most challenging Certification to qualify for. **The DBE Certification is a perfect stepping stone for businesses looking to increase their revenue.** 

Most of all, a **DBE Certification gives your firm access to purchasing networks**. An average entity cannot sell to corporate or nationally known companies. Equipped with a DBE Certification, your company will have access to large companies looking to meet their set-aside goals.

## Eligibility:

Thanks to the United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) being in control of the DBE Certification, **eligibility is almost identical in all states**. The following requirements are needed to qualify for the DBE Certification:

- A for-profit business 51% owned and controlled by one or more U.S. Citizens, or a legal resident (green card), who are socially and economically disadvantaged and fall into any of the following groups:
  - Asian-Pacific Americans
  - Hispanics (people of Spanish descent)
  - Subcontinent Asian Americans
  - African Americans
  - $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$  Native Americans
- Annual average income must not exceed \$26 million.
- The top executive officer, responsible for daily operations, is a disadvantaged individual with technical expertise.
